Ephesians 3.20-21

May God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ give to all Christian brothers and sisters peace and love with faith. May God's grace be with all those who love our Lord Jesus Christ with undying love.

Ephesians 6.23-24

Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and petition with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which passes all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4.4-7

Finally brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable – if anything is excellent or praiseworthy – think about such things. ... And the God of peace will be with you.

Philippians 4.8,9

Live a life worthy of the Lord, and please him in every way. Bear fruit in every good work; grow in the knowledge of God; be strengthened with all power according to his glorious might, so that you may have great endurance and patience. Joyfully give thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in the kingdom of light.

Colossians 1.10-12

Let the peace of Christ dwell in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful. Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly. ... And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

Colossians 3.15,16,17

May the Lord make your love increase and overflow for each other and for everyone else, just as ours does for you. May he strengthen your hearts so that you will be blameless and holy in the presence of our God and Father when our Lord Jesus comes with all his holy ones.

1 Thessalonians 3.12-13

1 Peter 5.10-11

Grow in grace and the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and forever! Amen.

To those who have been called, who are loved by God the Father and kept by Jesus Christ: mercy, peace and love be yours in abundance.

Jude 1.2
